He has bombed Berlin, Merseburg, Leipsiz, Anklam, Peenemunde, Ludwigshaven, Hamburg, Kiel, Cologne, Nienburg, Weimar, and other centers of Germany's war industry and holds the Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters. Captain Muffett attended Pasadena Junior College and was employed as a meter reader for the Southern California Gas Company before entering service Aug. 13, 1942.
